Venue: **Holiday Inn, Bloomsbury, Central London**

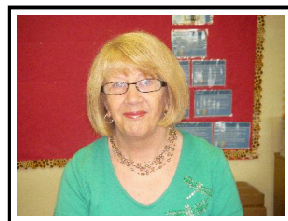
Cost: **£15 adults; £10 children (12-18yrs)**
