Background Information

- Epraise have been around for 10 years and the main company director is a teacher. They currently operate between 250-300 schools in the UK.
- There is an App for teachers, parents and students
- Teachers can reward points on the App and via the website.
- They offer ongoing support via phone or email to all main contacts as well as regular check ins to ensure that your school has everything they need in order to get the most out of epraise.
- We will be using epraise to award current Year 7 and 8 students reward points, with AROE at the forefront of our positive reward system. We will also be using epraise to manage our house events and house system. Every time a student is awarded points by showing Aspiration, Resilience, Opportunity or Excellence, their house is awarded points as well.

Your profile & quicklinks

When you initially login you will be presented with tutorials describing some of our different features, they will also appear when any changes or updates happen.







You may see a reminder asking you to confirm your email address, make sure you confirm this as it will affect other parts of the site if incorrect.

You have up to six quicklink icons - these are situated in the top right hand corner of your screen.

- Search icon the magnifying glass will allow you to search for either students, staff, parents or classes.
- Class icon will display today's timetable (if you have the MIS link enabled) or it will display your tutor group.
- Profile icon features the number of points you have left to award and then take you straight to your profile.
- Calendar icon if enabled, takes you to your planner which you can also access under the Me tab.
- Message icon if enabled, takes you to your messages which you can also access under the Me tab.
- Exit icon logs you out of the site.

Staff members with senior leader, school admin or Achievement permissions can award points to houses. Following a house event, HOF's can award house points to the relevant houses based on how they did(breakdown of points for 1st/2nd 3rd etc to be decided). Giving house points will not affect the weekly reward tally that you get in your account. Mr Shanahan can award house points on a behalf of a faculty following a house competition if there are any issues/complications. Just contact him directly with the necessary information.
