Job Title:	Junior Leadership Team
Responsible to:	Pupil Voice Lead (Mr Williams - RWi)
Role:	Represent peers and year group, working on issues within the school and wider community. The JLT are role models and uphold the ethos of the school.
Personal Skills / Qualities:	Problem solving, communication, collaboration/team work, leadership qualities, good oracy skills, opinionated, empathetic, good attendance, excellent behaviour, role model to others.
Applications:	Application forms are to be handed into Mr Williams in the September of each year. Mr Williams and the HOY will short list pupils, all pupils in the year group will then vote for the two successful candidates.
Positions:	4 positions per year groups in years 7-10 (position lasts for 1 year).
