

Pride Alliance Application Form

Are you a student who identifies as part of the LGBTQIA+ community? Do you want to be an Ally for the LGBTQ+ community? If so, the Pride Alliance might be for you. This will give you the opportunity actively engage with the community whilst supporting other students who might be struggling with their sexuality and/or gender, or any else they might want support with from a likeminded peer.

Being a part of the Pride Alliance will involve:

- Being a point of contact for other LGBTQIA+ students
- Encouraging inclusivity and representation in the school
- Engaging in conversations about how the school can better support you and your peers
- Directing LGBTQIA+ peers to in school and out of school support
- Creating an action plan on how to move forward, and implementing it.

Being a LGBTQIA+ Student Ambassador will NOT involve:

- Teaching peers about different identities – if someone is unsure, there are reputable information sources which can support them
- Telling peers what sexuality/gender they are
- Suggesting accessing support from inaccurate or unreliable sources, or places/website which are not age appropriate
