<b>Job Title:</b>	STEM Ambassador
<b>Responsible to:</b>	Mrs Williams (CWs) – STEM Leader
<b>Role:</b>	To encourage and inspire other young people to progress further in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM), through sharing their time, enthusiasm and experiences. Participating in a range of activities, including practical demonstrations, challenges, assemblies, talking to peers about their experiences and attending events, etc, which are essential for inspiring the next generation within the world of STEM subjects, future career and education choices.
<b>Personal Skills / Qualities:</b>	Keen interest in the way the world works & STEM subjects, positive mindset, good problem-solving skills, effective communicator, willingness to lead a team, good interpersonal skills, excellent attendance & punctuality.
