<b>Job Title:</b>	Digital Leader (Childnet).
<b>Responsible to:</b>	Mr Druce (MDr) and ICT department.
<b>Role:</b>	You will have the opportunity to impact policy by engaging with top tech companies and the Government having access to a network of Digital Leaders; being involved in future developments of the Childnet platform and their wider work. To support you in this role you will complete an online training activities to develop understanding of E-safety and dangers when being online.
