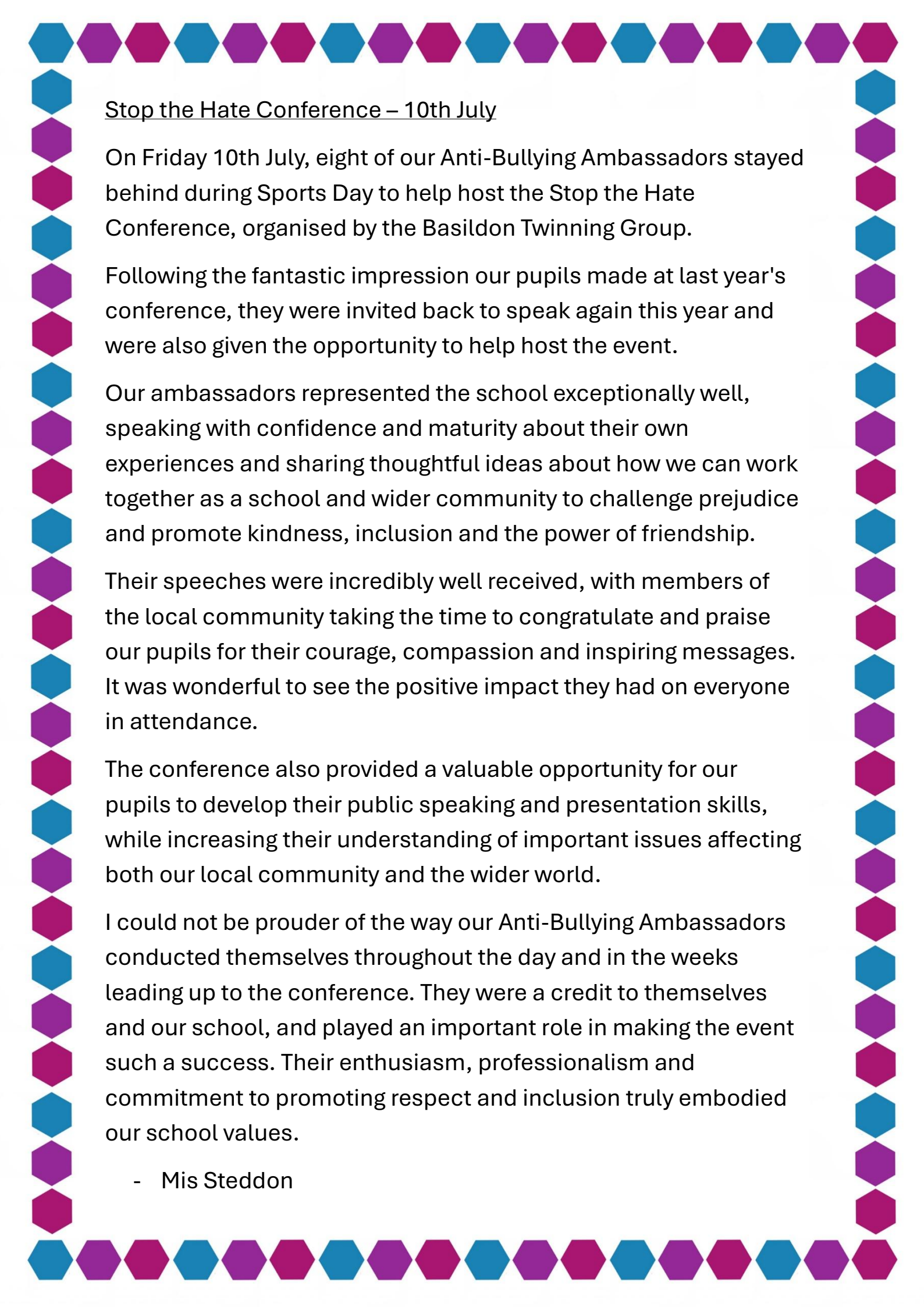




Stop the Hate Conference – 10th July
