AROE Parental Communication Calendar 2023-24

Year 7 – Relationships – Diversity (RELATIONSHIPS) -*This unit will cover diversity, prejudice, and bullying.*

Year 8 – Relationships – Discrimination (RELATIONSHIPS) - This unit will cover discrimination in all its forms including racism, religious discrimination, disability, discrimination, sexism, homophobia, biphobia, and transphobia.
