

Woodlands School Attendance League

How does it work?

Woodlands Attendance League works in a similar way to the football league. Each week points will be awarded to each tutor group for attendance and punctuality. 'Teams' are 'Tutor Groups' and move up and down the league table depending on the week's attendance and punctuality figures.

Points are allocated as follows

- 3 points – improved attendance
- 2 points – no change in attendance
- 1 points – decline in attendance (to reward students who have attended)

Bonus points

- 3 points – Teams achieving or exceeding school attendance target of 95%
- 3 points – Teams achieving 100% attendance
- 3 points – Teams achieving 100% punctuality

What's in it for me?

Individuals and 'Teams' can be rewarded for excellent attendance at certain points during the academic year:

Each week Teams with the highest points will be awarded with an 'attendance trophy'

Each week individuals with 100% attendance will be entered into a prize draw to attend the '100% brunch club'

The Team with the highest position in the Attendance League at the end of the academic year will be invited to attend a rewards trip to the Olympic Stadium home of West Ham United FC

Recognising the important role parents/carers plan in ensuring students attend every day and on time 100% attenders will be entered into a prize draw each half term to win a prize for parent/carer

Half termly students with excellent attendance will be entered into a prize draw
